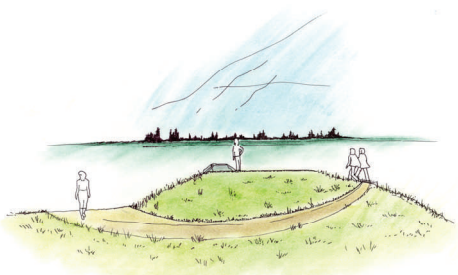
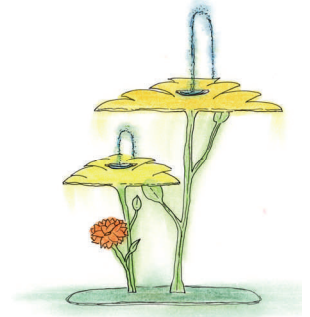
The park will consist of the following areas: The Depot (history); Riverwalk; High Plateau; Community Center; The Grove; The Farm (agriculture).

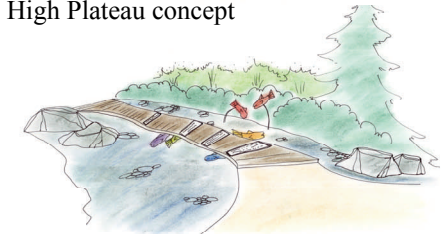

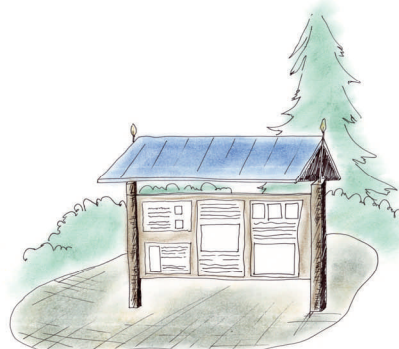
Water Fountain concept



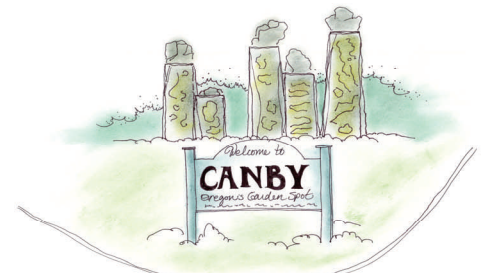
High Plateau concept



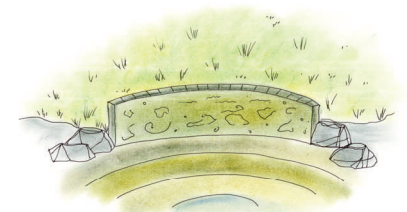
Riverwalk Artwork concept
