Location: Adopt a Road at Knights Bridge area by Canby Grove

**Recommended Clean-up Tasks for Area:**

1. Wipe down signs along location
2. Wipe down guardrails
3. Remove any expired signage such as garage sale signs
4. Pick up any trash or debris and bring back to Wait Park check in area for collection. DO NOT pick up any material that looks suspicious or unhealthy. Make a notation on this form and the City will be notified. Do not go off of Knightsbridge Road.
5. **Please survey your area before sending a crew out. From previous clean-ups in this area the following are suggested supplies:** Rakes, garbage bags, trash pickers or tongs (provided if requested), and pruning shears/clippers for vines. Shop rags and cleaner for signage. For workers gloves, orange safety vests, water, sunscreen, and cell phone is recommended. Having a crew leader(s) on bicycle to check in on workers along the route is helpful.
