**Recommended Clean-up Tasks for Area:**

1. Weed street area where sweeper can not reach and in sidewalk cracks.
2. Wipe down street signs from Ivy to Fir
3. Pick up trash or debris and put in dumpster behind City Hall or bring to Wait Park meeting area. **DO NOT** pick up any material that looks suspicious or unhealthy.
4. Sweep sidewalks of debris. Parking spot area tend to accumulate debris. Remove if possible. Do not do anything with the parking lot by railroad tracks across 1st Street
5. Remove any expired signage such as garage sale signs
6. Attend to barrels. Deadhead any flowers in barrels. Flowers will be provided at the Wait Park check-in area.

**Please survey your area before sending a crew out. From previous clean-ups in this area the following are suggested supplies:** Garbage bags, trash pickers or tongs (provided if requested), shop rags and cleaner for signage. For workers orange safety vests, gloves, water, sunscreen, and cell phone is recommended. Having a crew leader on a bicycle to check in on workers along the route is helpful.
