Location: Arrive day of and register at the ECO Park entrance- 1400 NE Territorial (just west of Redwood Ave)

Recommended Clean-up Tasks for Area:

- For safety and project planning, please--- it is best to arrive at 1 pm for intro talk. Latecomers can be briefed later if needed. we value your time and efforts, for even a short time. We will train you how to do it right if you've not pulled IVY before. Sign in and out at the event.
- A 4 yard Debris Container is being placed at entrance to the park to haul away all that is Removed ! - Courtesy of Jeff Snyder of the Canby Parks Dept.
- Bring your own Loppers (long-handled best , but even pruners will do), A small, easy to handle (non-electric) portable saw is ok if you are experienced. Gloves are the only essential item along with water and snacks. Most of the work is pruning vines off trees and pulling up ground vines that are smothering the forest plants. The newly opened space will be filled with native plants and shrubs in the fall every year.
- **Directions-** HWY 99 turn on NE Territorial rd- go less than a mile past Redwood Ave. 100 yards further turn right at Logging trail rd -entrance right at corner. Also , if coming from 99 near fred meyer plaza, go across 99 at the light (this is redwood ave) , end at territorial and go left 100 yds to entrance.

Remember, Pulling and chopping IVY not only helps the Park, but is a great way to get rid of ALL life's frustrations....
