Location: “Welcome to Canby” sign at 99e & Redwood, past Starbucks, under trestle area to Fairgrounds at Pine. (note: Crew can go past Redwood up 99e to the “Entering Canby” if time allows.

**Recommended Clean-up Tasks for Area:**

1. From Redwood Street follow 99e down to small “Welcome Sign” across from Starbucks, picking up trash/debris. Wash sign if possible (it’s very high and a ladder is unstable in that area. Takes a tall person)
2. Wipe Down “Welcome to Canby” sign
3. Remove any expired signage such as garage sale signs
4. Pick up any trash or debris and leave at site for pick up or bring back to Wait Park Gazebo if possible. Leave all suspicious trash or large debris and the report on this form what needs to be picked up by the city.
5. Weed around street signs but leave taller weeds by train tracks alone.
6. **Please survey your area before sending a crew out. From previous clean-ups in this area the following are suggested supplies:** Rakes, garbage bags, trash pickers or tongs (provided if requested), and pruning shears/clippers/weed eater for vines/around signs. Shop rags and cleaner for signage. For workers orange vests (provided if requested), long pants and sleeves gloves, water or Grande Iced Coffee, sunscreen, and cell phone is recommended.
