Recommended Clean-up Tasks for Area:

1. Weed planter strips
2. If available, use a weed eater for immediate surrounding area
3. Weed “Welcome to Canby Sign” area
4. Wipe Down “Welcome to Canby” sign
5. Remove any expired signage in immediate area such as garage sale signs. If available, drive Territorial to 99e removing expired signage
6. Pick up any trash or debris and leave at site for pick up
7. **Please survey your area before sending a crew out. From previous clean-ups in this area the following are suggested supplies:** Rakes, garbage bags, trash pickers or tongs (provided if requested), and pruning shears/clippers for trees. Shop rags and cleaner for signage. For workers gloves, water, sunscreen, and cell phone is recommended.
